Greetings Australian Mayflower members!

With the AGM weekend behind us, we're starting an exciting year working on new projects. It was wonderful that so many of our BOA members decided to re-nominate and we are supplemented by two new members on the BOA.

Through 2025-26 we are continuing the immensely successful **Pilgrim 101** series of informative historical narrations dealing with the elements of our Ancestors - their history in England, in Leiden and then in the New World at Plymouth. With the opening of our new **Members Only** section on our website (see page 2), members will be able to view past presentations, at times convenient to you. We are continuing our **Cousin's Coffee** sessions, which allow a friendly and enthusiastic discussion on the things that concern us in our ancestry.

In the mid-19th century, a much higher percentage of Americans were descended from our Mayflower ancestors. Thus, if we can track Americans coming to the Goldfields in that period, we may be able to contact many Australians with possible Mayflower descendancy. Once we build a link, we would encourage and assist them to trace their forebears and become members of our society. Greg Geoghegan has offered to lead this **Goldfields Project**, and we would encourage other interested people to volunteer.

There was a similar, though often earlier, influx into Australia of Americans who were whalers, many of them coming directly from Massachusetts or nearby states. We are hoping that before the end of the year we can make a start on this parallel project.

If you have any ideas that you would like to discuss or share, I would be delighted to hear from you.














AUSMD, Inc. 2025 Annual **AGM Meeting**














Social Event


